Though more than 74% of the country's people identify themselves as Roman Catholic and another 16% identify themselves as Christian, Brazil is a nation struggling with nominalism and spiritism. Of the 200 million people in the nation, 40 million Brazilians live below the poverty line. While the richest 10% of Brazilians garner nearly half the income of Brazil, the poorest 10% get less than 1%. In Rio de Janeiro, where "Christ the Redeemer" stands overlooking, 20-25% of the city's population lives in slums called favelas. Within these slums, hundreds of thousands of street children find themselves trapped in drug addiction, prostitution, and violence, and many suffer from AIDS.

Despite all of these sober facts, the number of evangelical believers in Brazil continues to grow and it has become a missionary-sending nation.

- Pray for spiritual maturity throughout Brazil's rapidly-growing evangelical church.
- Pray for the Spirit of God to transform lives within slums and other impoverished areas.
- Pray for missionaries to be sent to areas and roughly 130 tribes unreached by the Gospel.
